## TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

### PATTON HOMESTEAD / NORTH SHORE

Friday, June 15

The Patton Homestead, now known as Green Meadows Farm, has been in the Patton Family since 1928. In 1980 Major General George S. Patton IV and his family moved to the Homestead permanently. Major Gen. Patton named each of his fields for fallen heroes with whom he had served in Vietnam. Beginning with Yano Field in 1984, honoring Sgt. R.J.T. Yano of the Air Cavalry, seven fields now honor fellow veterans. The farm was once open to the public for tours, but has recently closed. However, with special permission, we will stop at the farm to pay our respects. Details of an abbreviated tour are still being planned. After the farm visit, we'll continue north to Gloucester, still a substantial fishing port. The coastal scenery is unsurpassed. Enjoy lunch at one of many restaurants in the area. Then, it's on to Rockport – Bearskin Neck – a neat area of shops, galleries, and restaurants with beautiful views of the harbor and ocean.

### BOSTON CITY TOUR

Saturday, June 16

Embark on a tour of a city so rich in history. On the way into downtown, drive by Bunker Hill Monument and the USS Constitution, known as Old Ironsides. Enjoy free time and lunch on your own at Quincy Market, also called Faneuil Hall Marketplace. There are over 100 stores, pushcarts, restaurants, and plenty of entertainment. Continue on a guided driving tour of Boston. See some of the most famous sites along the Freedom Trail including Boston Common, the forty-eight acre park where the British mustered for Lexington and Concord, the site of the Boston Massacre, and the Old North Church where the two lanterns were hung, "One if by Land, Two if by Sea", and other points of interest. Depending on events and traffic that day, more sites may be added.
